AUCHENTOSCHAN 12 (Clydebank, Lowlands) Oats - Lighter - Ginger

14

Curiously triple distilled. Bright gold. Attractive and pure oatmeal / muesli bar accent to the malt; gets more dried grass-like with exposure with hints of fruit. A clean, fresh delivery offers dilute honey, cereal and warming gingery moments to round off a soft-centred, light to mid weighted whisky that's a simple pleasure. 40% Alc.Vol.

BRUICHLADDICH CLASSIC LADDIE (Conisby, Islay)

Smooth - Vanilla - Macadamia

Possibly one of the last Laddie Classics created under the supervision of Master Distiller, Jim McEwan?

Better with water.

BUNNAHABHAIN STIUIREADAIR (Ardnahoe, Islay)

Seaspray - Smooth - Dried Fruits

Bunnahabhain Stiùireadair; pronounced 'stew-rahdur' and means 'helmsman' in Scots Gaelic. Natural colour, non-chill filtered and with a brackish, coastal tinge, this sherried malt whisky will transport you to Bunnahabhain Bay, with a smattering of sea spray and dried fruit lingering on your lips. 46.3% Alc./Vol.

PORT CHARLOTTE HEAVILY PEATED ISLAY MALT BY BRUICHLADDICH (Port Charlotte, Islay)

Peat - Vanilla - Macadamia

This Port Charlotte 10 year old has been conceived, distilled, matured and bottled on Islay alone. We are a young team with deep-rooted values, and an ambition to make the ultimate "Islay" Islay whisky. A whisky made by people not software; a whisky watched over every day of its maturing life by those who made it; a whisky born of a community with a vision and a mission to kick start a single malt whisky revolution, this Port Charlotte 10 year old is who we are. CAO ILA 12 (Port Askaig, Islay)

Fire on a stoney beach - Balance - Delicious

Pale straw colour with a subtle green blush. Aromas of soft, sweet peat - smoked trout, a hint of lanolin and some baked citrus. Rounded, pure and impeccably clean from start to finish, the palate offers semi-sweet smoky-fruity oily flavours counterpointed by super fine tannins. Perfect balance. Finishes long with salt, smoked fish and light lanolin through the fade. A gentler, more feminine and food friendly expression that Islay lovers should get to know. 43% Alc./Vol.

GLENFIDDICH 15 (Dufftown, Banffshire)

Bright - Rich - Solera

The richly layered Glenfiddich 15 Year Old single malt Scotch whisky is innovatively matured in three types of oak cask: sherry, bourbon and new oak, before being married in a handcrafted Solera vat that is never emptied,

Bright - Rich - Rum Barrel Notes

To create whisky with a tropical feel, our makers finished a portion of our smooth whisky in barrels that previously held Caribbean rum. The result is a well balanced and exceptionally smooth whisky. 40% Alc./Vol.

HIGHLAND PARK VIKING SCARS 12 (Orkney Islands)

Sun Ripe Citrus - Rich - Heathy Peat

Welcome to a wild harmony. This is a vibrant and smooth single malt, bursting with flavours of crushed citrus fruit and lightly whipped vanilla cream. You'll detect hints of heather honey in its aromatic peat smoke and just a trace of peppery spice. Delicious with pan-fried scallops wrapped in bacon or with a salted-honey vanilla cream parfait – you can use it to create a classic Old Fashioned too. 40% Alc./Vol.

LAGAVULIN 16

Smoke - Iodine - Bear Hug

Lagavulin legitimately claims to being one of the oldest distilleries in Scotland. Situated in a small bay near the south coast of Islay, Lagavulin stands near the ruins of Dunyveg Castle. From here 1,000 Islaymen set sail to fight alongside Robert the Bruce at Bannockburn in 1314, and in this bay the Macdonalds maintained their power base as Lords of the Isles until finally driven out by the Campbells three centuries later. Distilling on the site is thought to date from as early as 1742. 43% Alc./Vol.

LONGMORN 16 (Speyside)

Rich - Herbal - Dry & Full

Great nose; hazelnut, jam and citrus zest, almond, berries and cream, rose. Big palate, creamy oily nutty chewy caramel. Lasting nutty flavour 48% Alc./Vol.

LONGROW BY SPRINGBANK 7 (Campbeltown)

Rich - Herbal - Dry & Full

This unusual seven year old Longrow is another edition to their "Wood Expression" series and was matured for five and a half years in refill Bourbon casks and then one and a half further years in fresh Gaja Barolo casks (Barolo is a famous and sought after Italian Red wine produced from the Nebbiolo grape). Free of artificial colouring & non-chill filtered. 55.8% Alc./Vol. Distilled October 2000. Bottled January 2008. 12,120 bottles produced.

MACALLAN 12 SHERRY OAK (SPEYSIDE)

Malty - Vanilla - Classic

This whisky has a rich golden colour. The nose is complex with hints of vanilla. A smooth palate with a medium balance of oak, fruit, and spice. The finish is long, again with oak, fruit, and spice. The finish is medium to long, with spicy sherry.

ARCHIE ROSE SINGLE MALT (Roseberry, Sydney) Shortbread - Toffee - Amaretto

Archie Rose Single Malt Whisky is distinctly crafted to highlight six malts, each with a unique profile and character. This six-malt mash bill, although incredibly low yielding, provides a rich and expressive flavour, full of distinct regional character. Matured predominantly in 100, 200 and 300-litre Australian Apera (Sherry) casks, complemented by a selection of Ex-Bourbon and Archie Rose's own 36-month air dried Ex-Rye Casks, each coopered with a specific balance of both char and toast. 46% Alc./Vol.

HELLYERS ROAD PINOT CASK (Tasmania)

Imaginative - Red fruits - Malt

The nose is immediately drawn to crisp summer citrus, lemon and orange that obediently withdraws on the palate to manifest a sweet, gentle layer of pepper and spice – a persuasion of Tasmania's more delicate and sophisticated cool climate red wine cameos. Stewed blackberry sauce lingers on the finish, foreclosing to a treasured but bewildering play upon the senses.

REDBREAST 27 (Ireland)

Bright Fruit - Wood spice - Dry Finish

A succulent medley of exotic fruits, mango, pineapple, blood orange and ripe red berries are complemented by fresh herbs, aromatic oils and wood spices. Vanilla sweetness and treacle toffee add to the richness, while walnuts and toasted oak acknowledge the contribution from a supreme cask selection. Incredibly rich in texture with a luxuriously fruity introduction. Ripe red fleshed plums, black cherries and summer berries are balanced by the prickle of a hint of chili oil. The taste evolves as cherry menthol introduces vanilla and cinnamon sweet spices combined with red pepper, nutmeg and toasted oak for an intriguing complexity. A satisfyingly long balance of ripe fruit and wood spices, worthy of a journey of nearly three decades.. Bottled at Cask Strength @ 53.5% Alc./Vol.

METHOD & MADNESS SINGLE POT STILL - SHERRY & BOURBON (Ireland)

Dried fruits - Caramel fudge - French Chestnut

When it comes to selecting casks, its not often we deviate from the oak family. so finishing a single pot still irish whiskey in chestnut casks same with a measure of guilt. up on tasting the result, we quickly got over it.

This release asked the question: How will virgin spanish oak affect a light single grain whiskey? without giving too much away, the two made very good partners, offering a perfect mix of wood spice playing off the natural sweetness of the grain. 46% Alc./Vol.

Matured in a selection of ex-bourbon and ex-sherry casks, this produces a perfectly balanced Single Pot Still expression.

Nose: Mown hay & cracked black pepper. red bell peppers, nutmeg, clove oil & green tea. Sweet honey & peaches from the malaga casks.

Taste: Honey sweetness with the pot still spices. Flavours of fresh coffee, creamy milk chocolate & creme brulee. Notes of red apples & toasted oak

Finish: Sophisticated & complex. Sweetness throughout, with a mix of red grape & dry barley upon exit. 46% Alc./Vol.

SLIABH LIAG SILKIE (Ireland)

Butterscotch - Green Apple - Stem Ginger

They have sourced a blend of grain and malt whiskeys that when blended together produce a signature soft mouth feel. The end result is a straw gold colour with hints of amber. The nose is malty and fresh, green apples, and opens to a honey butteriness. The palate is soft honey, with hints of brioche, butterscotch, digestive biscuits, orange zest, and stem ginger. It finished warm and elegant.
